Criteria	Score	Comments
1. Understanding the Problem: Extent to which participants -demonstrates a clear understanding of the issues involved -presents convincing evidence that there is a problem -explains why government should be involved in the solution		
2. Analysis of Alternative Policies: Extent to which participants -explains costs and benefits of two or three alternative policies -documents high quality research from multiple sources -identifies controversies and conflicts to be addressed -explains role of citizen volunteers in solving problem, if appropriate		
3. Policy Development: Extent to which participants -supports position with sound reasoning and evidence -features a policy that is clearly stated and realistic -reflects informed advocacy for the position -explains why the policy is constitutional		
4. Action Plan: Extent to which participants -proposes action that builds/expands on previous portfolio panels -proposes action that is realistic -indicates how to contact appropriate agencies/levels of government -includes activities that impact and inform the community		
5. Reflection: Extent to which participants -respond to the questions with information/perspective -articulate what they have learned from the project		
6. Oral Presentation Skills: Extent to which participants -exhibit eye contact, poise, delivery (pace, projection, articulation) -answer questions asked and move listeners -are responsive to audience questions -share responsibilities for the presentation
