Nomination

A classroom teacher, administrator, parent, public employee, or citizen may nominate a portfolio at any time and provide a narrative that touches on the criteria listed below.

Criteria

1. Evidence of identification of and effective contact with stakeholders.
2. Evidence that the portfolio process worked to bring various stakeholders together in order to reach consensus and a public-policy solution.
3. Approximate time line from problem identification to implementation of public-policy solution.
4. Examples of specific actions taken leading to implementation.
5. Impact of the project on the community.

Note: This need not be a 2005-06 school year project but one from previous years.
